



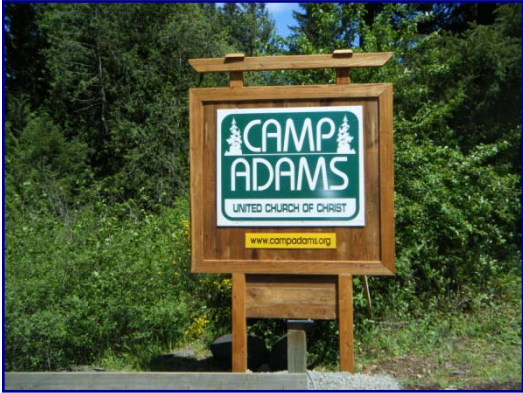

Camp Adams is a host site for the ministries of the Central Pacific Conference, United Church of Christ. This scenic 218 acre Retreat and Conference Center is available to 501c3 groups seeking an environment which accommodates a variety of programs for persons of all ages. The grounds are able to accommodate several User Groups at the same time.



The Nate Creek Site provides a large gymnasium, dining hall, lounge, sleeping cabins with kitchens, campfire ring, outdoor chapel, craft pavilion, Nate Creek, Labyrinth and large playing field.

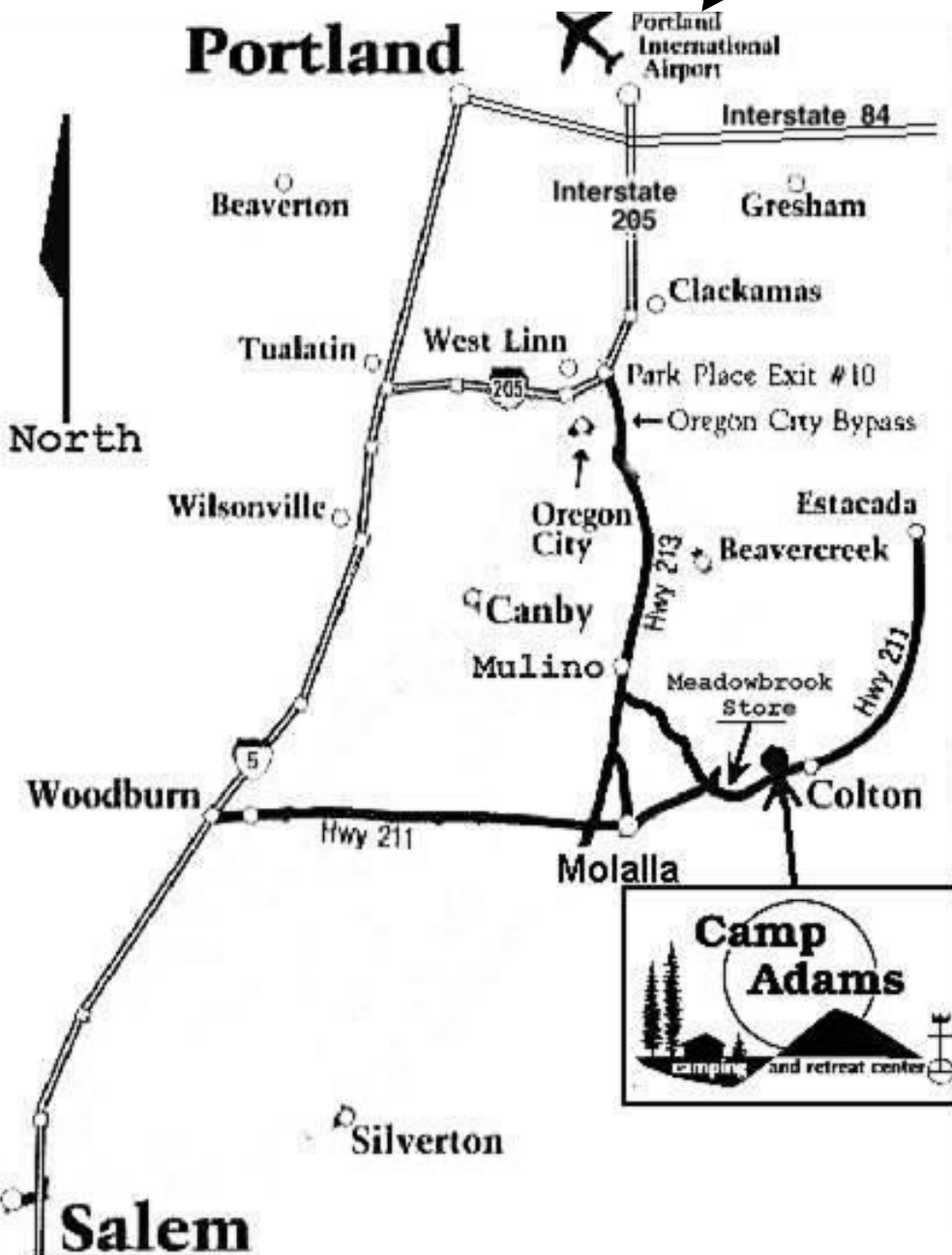


The Milk Creek Site provides a large flexible use facility, sleeping cabins, retreat houses, large playing field, outdoor chapel, campfire ring and at the convergence of Milk and Nate Creeks, is a large swimming hole.

Serving both sites are numerous walking and hiking trails, old growth forest, trust course, and a marvelous view of Mt. Hood and the Willamette Valley. You will find included a complete description of the facilities, the number of guests they will accommodate, meal service plans, rate schedule for lodging and meals, and site policies and information. From I-5 South: Take I-5 to the Woodburn exit 271 and turn east (left). This is Highway 214. Stay on 214 through Woodburn; it becomes Highway 211 as it crosses 99E. Follow 211 past Molalla 3 miles to the 4 way stop where the highway curves to the right. Follow on 211 about 3 miles to Camp Adams which is located between mile markers 18 and 19, ¾ mile past marker 18, on the left side of the highway.

From I-5 North: Take I-5 to 205 north. Take exit 10 off 205, turn south (right) on Highway 213. Continue south past Mulino about 1 mile to the Union Mills road turn off (you can only turn left). Continue 4 miles to the 4-way stop. Go straight through the intersection—you are now on Highway 211—and drive about 3 miles to Camp Adams, located on the left side of the highway. The camp is located between mile markers 18 and 19, ¾ mile past marker 18.

From I-84 East: Take I-84 West to the I-205 south exit. Take exit 10 off 205 and turn south (left) on Highway 213. Continue south past Mulino about 1 mile to the Union Mills road turnoff; you can only turn left. Continue 4 miles to the 4-way stop. Go straight through the intersection—you are now on Highway 211—and drive about 3 miles to Camp Adams, located on the left side of the highway. The camp is located between mile markers 18 and 19, ¾ mile past marker 18.

CAMP ADAMS FACILITIES

2MILK CREEK SITE:



Waverly Cabin (Available year round) Sleeps a total of 24 (12 bunks per side).

1. 1 bathroom off each dorm room
2. Electric heat though out.
3. Large meeting area.
4. Kitchen complete with utensils & dishes provided.
5. Microwave, electric stove and refrigerator.
6. Separate dining hall
7. Large deck with picnic table overlooking Milk Creek.

Fir Cone Cabin (Available year round) Sleeps a total of 28 (14 bunks per side).

1. 1 bathroom off each dorm room.
2. Electric heat throughout.
3. Large multi-purpose space for meeting and dining.
4. Kitchen complete (Cooking and eating utensils

provided).

5. Electric heat in all bunks rooms.

Opsund Cabin (Available year round – Adult or Family use only) Opsund sleeps 10-14. There are 4 bedrooms

1. 2 bathrooms.
2. Electric heat throughout. Wood stove in lounge
3. Lounge
4. Kitchen with dining table

Pilgrim Cabin (Available March through October) Sleeps 20 in two bedrooms.

1. 2 bathrooms.
2. Common area in middle.

Antlers Cabin (Available March through October) Sleeps 24 in two bedrooms.

1. 1 bathroom
2. Not currently practical for co-ed use.

Staff Cottage: A two bedroom cottage sleeps up to 3 guests and includes a small kitchen, private shower and a living/dinning room area.

Sunrise Cabin (Available March through October) Sleeps 18 in two bedrooms.

1. 1 bathroom.
2. Not currently practical for co-ed use.

Morris Lodge: (Available Year Round) Large flexible-use space with dining capacity for 140.

1. Electric Heat w/ wood fireplace.
2. Great for day retreats

NATE CREEK SITE:

All Facilities are winterized and thus available for year round use

Alpha & Hope Cabins: Sleeps 20 in two dorm rooms.

1. 1 bathroom off each dorm room.
2. Common area in middle with couches.
3. Small kitchen with dishes & utensils.

Stafford Cabin: Sleeps 24.

1. Two dorm rooms on main level each accommodating 10 guests
2. 1 bathroom off of each dorm room.
3. 1 handicapped accessible restroom on main level.
4. Two bedrooms upstairs with 2 beds in each.
5. 1 restroom upstairs.
6. Common area downstairs.
7. Small kitchen with dishes & utensils.

Bond and Ross Cabins: Each cabin sleeps 20 in two dorm rooms.

1. 1 bathroom off each dorm room.
2. Common Area downstairs.



Administration Building:

1. Upstairs: 2 bedrooms with two twin beds each.
2. 1 bathroom upstairs
3. Downstairs: 4 bedrooms with two with 2 beds each and 2 with one bed each.
4. 2 bathrooms downstairs
5. There is a room with a hospital bed and first aid supplies.
6. Office space with storage.

Adkins Lodge:

1. This lodge has 2 sections.
2. One section is dining area with dining capacity for 160.
3. Restrooms.
4. Separate section for meeting space with a few couches.
5. Forced air furnace heat.
6. Large T.V.
7. Reading and Wi-Fy lounge
8. Fireplace.
9. Piano.
10. PA System

All fifteen bathrooms at the Nate Creek Site have been remodeled.

Trinity Hall: Capacity: 200

1. Adjacent to Adkins Lodge.
2. Similar to a gymnasium.
3. Complete with basketball and volleyball equipment.
4. Recreation Room with pool tables, ping pongs and fussball table.



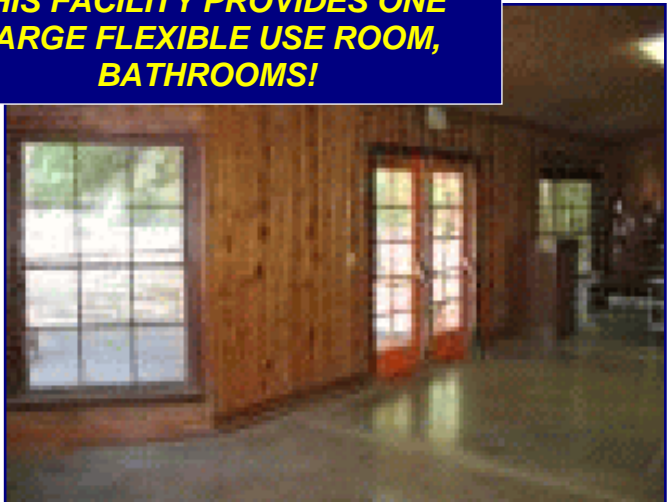
ADKINS LODGE AND TRINITY HALL

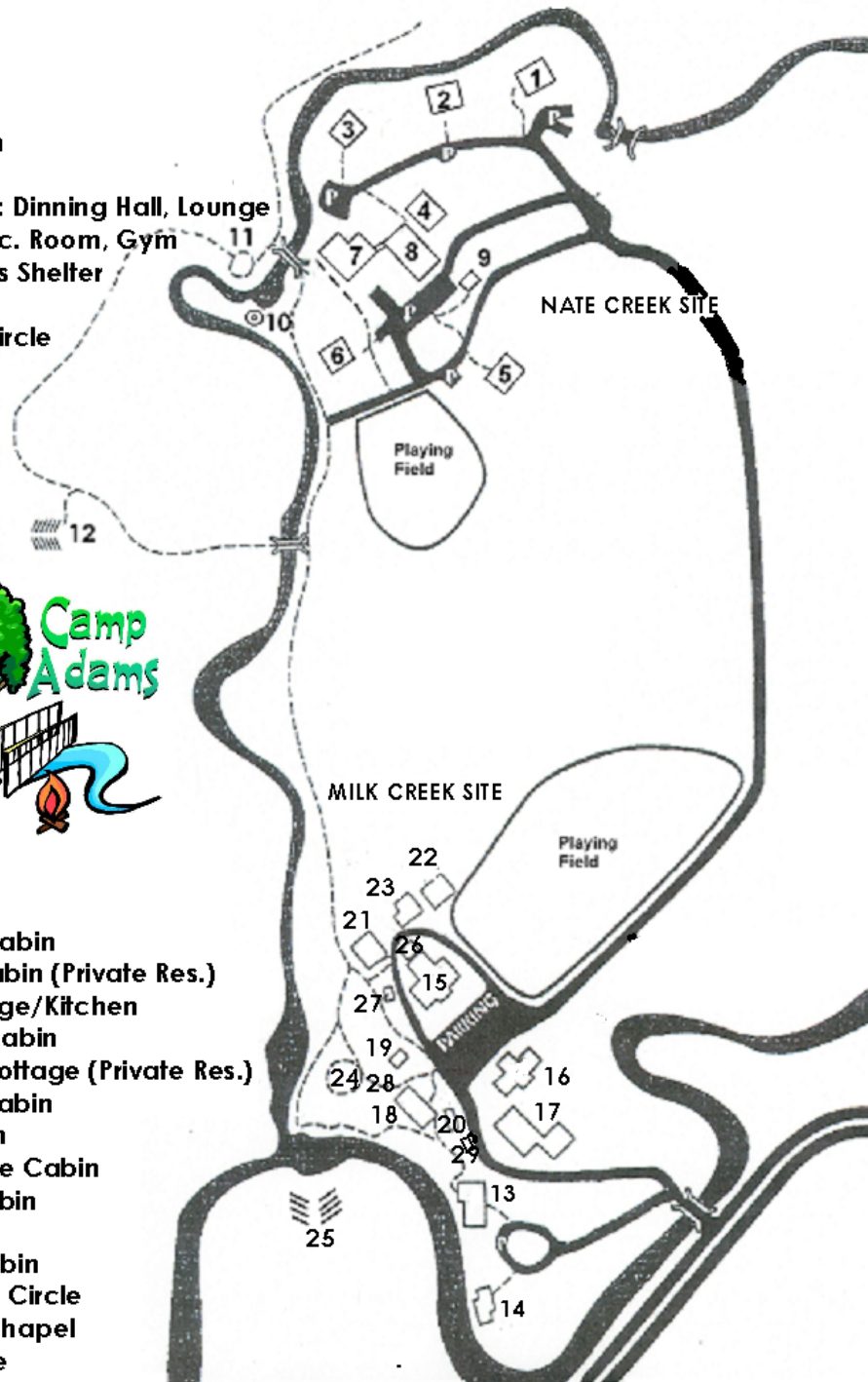

CURRENT MENUS BEING OFFERED AT FOR CAMP ADAMS

All meals at Camp Adams include items to satisfy vegetarians. We attempt to accommodate vegans and those on special diet restrictions. Those with special diets restrictions may wish to bring items to supplement their meals.

A refrigerator is provided to store perishable items. A group may mix and match menu selections. Exact meal cost will be applied to the final invoice.

BREAKFAST CHOICES: Breakfast at Camp Adams is served buffet style. Breakfast entrees are served along with peanut butter and jam, cold cereals, coffee, tea and milk.

- B1.** \$7.00: Breakfast bar: granola, fresh fruit and pastry
- B2.** \$7.00: Oatmeal, brown sugar, raisins, hard boiled eggs, oranges and muffins
- B3.** \$9.00: Pancakes with syrup and jam, sausage and fruit
- B4.** \$9.00: Vegetarian quiche and/or ham quiche, fresh fruit, pastry
- B5.** 11.00: French toast with syrup, jam & powdered sugar, sausage and fruit
- B6.** \$11.00: Ham Scrambled Eggs, hash browns, hot biscuits*, honey & jam
- B7.** \$11.00: Breakfast Casserole: Casserole includes eggs, potatoes, ham and/or sausage, biscuits (Not homemade) and fresh fruit:

LUNCHEON CHOICES: Lunch at Camp Adams is served buffet style. The following lunch entrees are served with relishes, peanut butter and jam, fresh fruit, homemade cookies, milk, tea & coffee. A full salad bar is available at an additional \$1.50 per guest.

In those cases the guest group demonstrates a need to provide meals which speak to the spiritual, dietary, and ethnic needs of its group which the camp's food service staff may not be able to provide. When such a need is demonstrated the following rates prevail:</p>		
Lodging/Kitchen Rental (12 and older)	\$36.00	Per night
Lodging/Kitchen Rental (4 – 11 year old guest)	\$26.00	Per night
Kitchen Companion	\$30.00	Per meal
Kitchen Custodial Fee	\$100.00	Per event
<p>A minimum number of 35 guests are required to use a Camp Adams Licensed Kitchen. Fully supplied kitchens in several cabins accommodate groups less than 35. A guest-group is required to provide a person with a Food Handlers Card in the licensed kitchen during food preparation. (May be obtained on line) The Kitchen Companion is present to provide assistance in the use of the kitchen and its equipment. The Discount Rate Schedule above applies to those groups permitted to do their own cooking.</p>
